All funds are in the black overall, we are deficit spending by approximately \$222,000 yearly. Most of the shortfall in funds is related to the O & M account which is directly related to our buildings and grounds. This is not unusual for districts that contend with older buildings such as the high school.

The use of federal funds has allowed the district to save in other areas and should leave us in decent shape once the funding stops.

Increases in EBF, and the 1% tax has also increased over the last year which is also beneficial. The state as of today are paying all of their obligations.
